Important Upcoming Deadlines: Last Day to File Nominating Petitions is March 6, 10-Day Challenge Period begins March 9

Washington, DC – The District of Columbia Board of Elections (DCBOE) is reminding all candidates and the public of two important deadlines in the ballot access process for the June 4, 2024 Primary Election:

• March 6, 2024: Deadline for candidates to file nominating petitions, petition supplements, and/or any additional forms necessary for ballot access in the June 4, 2024 Primary Election.

All required documents should be filed at DCBOE's offices at 1015 Half Street, SE, Suite 750 by 5:00 pm on March 6, 2024. Candidates should arrive with their petition sheets counted/numbered and other documents ready to file.

• March 9, 2024: Nominating petitions are posted for the 10-day challenge period that ends on Monday, March 18, 2024 at 5:00 pm.

In addition to its normal weekday hours of 8:15 am to 4:45 pm, DCBOE will be open weekends (Saturday, March 9; Sunday, March 10; Saturday, March 16; and Sunday, March 17, 2024) from 8:30 am to 4:45 pm during the challenge process.
