## **Election Day, June 19, Is One Week Away**

**WASHINGTON, D.C.** - The DCBOE would like to remind voters that Primary Election Day, June 19, is one week away. While you can still vote early at any of our nine District-wide Early Voting Centers until June 15, if you would prefer to cast your ballot on Election Day, please confirm your polling place online at <https://www.vote4dc.com/SearchElection/SearchByAddress>.

If you have moved and have not updated your voter registration, or you are registering for the first time, please report to the precinct assigned to your **new/current address**. You will need to bring proof of your address with you on Election Day – acceptable proofs of address are:

- Current and valid District of Columbia DMV-issued ID
- Government check or paycheck,
- Bank statement\* (must be dated on or after March 19)
- Current utility bill\* (must be dated on or after March 19)
- Student housing statement/tuition bill
- Homeless shelter occupancy statement
- Lease
- Other government document with your name and address

The DCBOE would also like to remind you that lines may be longer first thing in the morning, and after 5pm on Election Day. Please plan accordingly.
