## **All Early Voting Centers Open on June 8**

**WASHINGTON, D.C.** - Early Voting began at One Judiciary Square on June 4<sup>th</sup>, but begins at eight additional ward-based Early Voting Centers tomorrow, June 8. D.C. residents can vote at **any** Early Voting Center, regardless of where in the District they reside. Voters can also register **same day** at any Early Voting Center with proof of address – acceptable proofs of address are listed on our website at [www.dcboe.org](http://www.dcboe.org). All Early Voting Centers will be open until June 15.

If you plan to wait and cast your ballot on Election Day, June 19, you must vote at the precinct assigned to your current address. Polls open at 7am and close at 8pm, but voters should expect longer wait times at their polling places before and after work hours. Shorter waits are expected between 10am and 5pm, so please plan accordingly.

But most importantly, get out and vote!
