DCBOE Receives “A” Ranking from Brookings Institute on Preparedness for Voting By Mail in 2020 Primary Election

WASHINGTON, D.C. - The District of Columbia Board of Elections (DCBOE) received an “A” ranking from the Brookings Institute on the Vote-By-Mail Pandemic Preparedness scorecard.

The state-by-state scorecard assessed each of the 50 states, including Washington DC, on various factors, such as requesting, completing, and submitting a mail-in ballot. In earning a Grade “A” (Score: 19/22), DCBOE is recognized for performance, preparedness and providing voters with a safe and secure voting experience during a pandemic.
