Have you Moved? Please Update your Address with DCBOE

WASHINGTON, D.C. – As the June 19, 2018 Primary Election approaches, the District of Columbia Board of Elections (DCBOE) would like to encourage all District residents to make sure that we have your current residence address. This information is important even if you have moved within the District, as your address determines your voting precinct and Election Day polling place.

Please visit [our website](#) to view the address and other registration information that the DCBOE has on file for you, and make any necessary corrections. The deadline to update your voter registration information online is **May 29, 2018**. However, you may update your registration information when you vote during early voting or on Election Day. Please keep in mind that if you update your address on Election Day, you should do so at the polling place that serves the address that you have moved to so that you can cast a live ballot in your new voting precinct, and that you will need to bring current and valid proof of residence.
