DCBOE Will Conduct Recounts in Four ANC Races

WASHINGTON, D.C., On November 30, 2018, the District of Columbia Board of Elections (DCBOE) will begin conducting recounts of the ballots cast in four Advisory Neighborhood Commissioner (ANC) races held during the November 6, 2018 General Election. The races to be recounted are as follows:

- ANC for Single Member District (SMD) 4B09
- ANC for SMD 8E01
- ANC for SMD 5E05
- ANC for SMD 4C08

These recounts will be conducted pursuant to requests made by candidates in each contest. The recounts will begin at 10:00 am and conclude at close of business, each day, and will continue from day to day until they are completed or a request to terminate any recount is received from a requesting party.

Candidates in each of the races have been notified of the recounts, and may send up to two observers to be present during the recounts. Members of the public may also observe the recounts. Following the termination of the recounts, DCBOE will post the results, but will only re-certify the results of a race if the outcome of that contest is changed.

The District of Columbia Board of Elections is an independent agency of the District of Columbia Government responsible for the administration of elections, ballot access, and voter registration.
