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DCBOE Publishes Results of the Manual Audit

WASHINGTON, D.C. – The District of Columbia Board of Elections (DCBOE) has completed the public manual audit of the November 3, 2020 General Election, which took place on Monday, November 23 and Tuesday, November 24, 2020.

As required by District law, the DCBOE conducted a hand count of all votes cast in one randomly selected precinct per ward in one citywide contest (Initiative 81) and two ward-wide contests for the audit (Ward 8 Member of the Council and Ward 4 Member of the State Board of Education).

The results of the audit are as follows:

Typically, differences between the hand count and the machine count are the result of additional or incomplete marks made by a voter on the ballot or the result of counting errors made by members of the audit team.

The margins of error do not exceed the statutory allowance of 0.25%, and therefore, no further action is required by the Board. Official results of the November 3, 2020 General Election will be certified during the Board's regular public meeting on December 2, 2020 at 11:00 am.
