DCBOE Update for Military and Overseas Voters in the November 6, 2018 General Election

WASHINGTON, D.C. - The District of Columbia Board of Elections (DCBOE) provides the following update to military and overseas civilian voters regarding the outcome of the candidate ballot order lottery, which was held on Friday, September 14, 2018.

The General Election ballot will include the federal contest for Delegate to the United States House of Representatives. The ballot positions for candidates in that contest are as follows:

- Bruce Majors (Libertarian)
- Natale "Lino" Stracuzzi (Statehood Green)
- Eleanor Holmes Norton (Democratic)
- John Cheeks (Independent)
- Nelson F. Rimensnyder (Republican)

DCBOE encourages all military and overseas voters to plan ahead to ensure their ability to participate in the Tuesday, November 6, 2018 General Election. As a reminder, all military and overseas voters who wish to register by mail, email, or fax must submit their applications by **Tuesday, October 16, 2018**. Absentee ballot requests must be received by **Saturday, November 3, 2018**. Completed absentee ballots, including those that are mailed, faxed, or e-mailed, must be RECEIVED by **8 pm on Election Day, Tuesday, November 6, 2018**.
