WASHINGTON, D.C. - The District of Columbia Board of Elections (DCBOE) is excited to share our schedule of events in celebration of National Voter Registration Day (NVRD), which is Tuesday, September 25. NVRD is a national holiday celebrating our democracy. It first began in 2012, and its purpose is to ensure a national effort is made to enfranchise voters.

DCBOE is hosting the following registration drives to get eligible residents registered and ready in advance of the General Election on November 6. We will have giveaways at all of our NVRD events!

To register to vote in the District, residents must: be 16 (17-year-olds may vote in a Primary Election, as long as they are 18 by the General Election), have lived in the District for 30 days, be U.S. citizens, not be incarcerated serving a sentence for a crime that is a felony in the District, and have not been declared incompetent to vote by a court of law.

In addition to in person registration, registration is also available by mail, online at www.vote4dc.com, and via the Vote4DC mobile app. A proof of D.C. address must be included using these methods. A full listing of acceptable proofs of address may be found on our website at www.dcboe.org.

The District of Columbia Board of Elections is an independent agency of the District of Columbia Government responsible for the administration of elections, ballot access, and voter registration.
