
ORDER

This matter came to be heard by the Board on Wednesday, February 2, 2000 at 10:00 a.m. pursuant to the submission of a Petition by the Office of Campaign Finance (hereinafter "OCF") for Enforcement of its July 7, 1999 Order ("Order") imposing a fine of \$500.00 against James Caviness, Candidate for Mayor ("Respondent"). The fines were imposed as a result of the Respondent's failure to file an October 10, 1998 Report of Receipts and Expenditures ("Report") by the due date as required by D.C. Code § 1-1416(a)(1999 Repl. Vol.).

As it appears to be the case that the address for the Respondent as maintained by OCF and provided to the Board was incorrect, and that this error prevented proper service of notice concerning this matter to the Respondent by OCF and the Board, it is this 4th day of January, 2000,

ORDERED that this matter be remanded back to the Office of Campaign Finance
for proper service.¹
