ADA Compliance Assistant Application

Eligibility Criteria:

To serve as an ADA Compliance Assistant, you must meet the following criteria:

- Be at least 18 years of age
- Be authorized to work in the United States
- Have access to reliable transportation

Requirements:

- Complete the training class (4 hrs)
- Available on Election Day from 6:00 am – 8:00 pm (June 2, 2020)
- (Optional) Assist in setting up your assigned polling places the Monday before Election Day (June 1, 2020)

Selection Process:

- Submission of an application does not guarantee that you will be selected
- Not all volunteers will be assigned to their preferred polling places
