



AFFIDAVIT OF ASSISTANT FORM

If an applicant for voter registration cannot write, they may make their mark in the space for a signature. However, if due to a disability, an applicant is unable either to sign or mark the registration form, an Affidavit of Assistant form must be provided by any person who assists the applicant in the registration process. The assistant may be an employee of the Board of Elections or someone of the applicant's own choosing – a friend, family member, or care provider.

The Affidavit of Assistant form is shown below. If used, it must be stapled to the Registration Form that will be forwarded to the Board of Elections. Please reproduce for agency use as necessary.
