Dear Executive Director Monica H. Evans,

As requested in your letter dated September 27<sup>th</sup>, I am writing to notify the District of Columbia Board of Elections that the District of Columbia Libertarian Party intends to conduct an election for members and officials of its local committee during the June 21, 2022 Primary Election.

Also as requested, the D.C. Libertarian Party's ("DCLP") plan for the election is as follows:

**I. Plan:**

The DCLP currently plans to hold a Convention on February 26<sup>th</sup>, 2022 (subject to change). During the convention, we will confirm our candidates that will be running in the Primary Election for each of the titles listed in Section II, III, and IV below. We will send an official list of the Libertarian Party candidates running for each position within 7 days of the conclusion of our convention. We will help candidates collect signatures, to the extent legally permitted in the [D.C. Code](#). When a candidate surpasses the required signatures in his/her respective nominating petition, we will file it within the period of February 28 to March 23 (5:00pm). As required by [DCLP's bylaws](#), only one candidate may be selected to be the nominee of the Libertarian Party for each partisan office, with the exception of the DC Council where the DCLP may select as many nominees as there are seats up for election. We will then support our chosen nominees in the General Election on November 8, 2022.

- d. At-large Member of the Council of the District of Columbia
- e. Attorney General for the District of Columbia
- f. United States Representative

**IV. Title of offices to be elected by Ward (4)**

- a. Ward 1: Member of the Council of the District of Columbia
- b. Ward 3: Member of the Council of the District of Columbia
- c. Ward 5: Member of the Council of the District of Columbia
- d. Ward 6: Member of the Council of the District of Columbia
