District of Columbia Board of Elections to Hold Ballot Lottery

WASHINGTON, D.C. – The District of Columbia Board of Elections (DCBOE) will conduct a lottery tomorrow, February 7, 2014, at 12:00pm to determine the order of candidates appearing on the ballot for the April 1, 2014 Primary Election. The lottery will consist of a random drawing by DCBOE’s Registrar of Voters.

The April 1 Primary is “closed” election, in that only registered Democrats, Republicans, Libertarians, or DC Statehood Green Party members may participate in their respective party primaries. Each primary winner will be added to the ballot in the General Election in November. The General Election is open to all eligible voters.

The District of Columbia Board of Elections is an independent agency of the District of Columbia Government responsible for the administration of elections, ballot access, and voter registration.
