## **April 1, 2014 Primary Election Begins at 7am at 143 Locations**

*Polls close at 8pm*

**WASHINGTON, DC** – The District of Columbia Board of Elections (DCBOE) reminds voters that all 143 polling precincts will open tomorrow, April 1, at 7am. Polls close at 8pm. Any voters waiting in line by this time will be allowed to cast a ballot.

**All registered Democrats, Republicans, Libertarians, and DC Statehood Party Green members may report to their assigned precincts to cast ballots for their party candidates.** Current registered voters may not change their party affiliation, as the deadline to do so was March 4, 2014. Same-day registration is available on Election Day. Registration applicants must show proof of residence such as a driver's license, government check or paycheck, lease, utility bill, bank statement or government document showing an address in the District.
