Early Voting Begins Monday, June 8 for the June 16, 2026 Primary and Special Elections

WASHINGTON, D.C. – The District of Columbia Board of Elections (DCBOE) wants to remind District of Columbia voters that Early Voting for the June 16, 2026 Primary and Special Elections is open from Monday, June 8 to Sunday, June 14, 2026.

25 Early Voting Vote Centers will be open daily from 8:30 am to 7:00 pm. Wait times and locations for Early Voting Vote Centers can be found at <https://earlyvoting.dcboe.org/>.

Voters may vote at any of the 25 Early Voting Vote Centers, regardless of their residential address.
