HOW CAN I REGISTER?

BY MAIL: Print a voter registration application at www.dcboe.org or call the Board of Elections at 202.727.2525 to request an application.

ONLINE: Download the free mobile app, Vote4DC, or complete and submit a voter registration form online at www.vote4dc.com.

IN PERSON: Register same-day at an Early Voting Center or at the polling place on Election Day that serves the precinct where you live. Bring an acceptable proof of address when you go to vote. For a complete list of proofs of address, visit www.dcboe.org.

WHERE DO I VOTE?

Voters are required to vote at their designated polling places on Election Day. Polling places are accessible, in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). To confirm your designated polling place, visit www.dcboe.org.
