3 MR. THOMPSON: All right. Well, hello  
4 everybody, welcome. We have a very brief special  
5 meeting today. My name is Gary Thompson, the  
6 Chair of the D.C. Board of Elections. With us  
7 via Zoom is my fellow Board Member, Karyn  
8 Greenfield, so we have a quorum. A very brief  
9 agenda has been distributed and I'll move that we  
10 adopt that agenda.

11 MS. GREENFIELD: Second.

12 MR. THOMPSON: All right. Well, the  
13 eyes clearly have it. And so, with that I will  
14 turn it over to our Executive Director, Monica  
15 Evans, to tell us what we're doing.

16 MS. EVANS: Thank you. So, we are  
17 here to certify election results for ANC 6B04.  
18 When we certified results on December 2nd, we did  
19 not have the most accurate write-in count. And  
20 so, we wanted to ensure that we had those numbers  
21 done correctly before certifying that contest,  
22 and so I present to you ANC 6B04 write-in contest

1 winner, Brian Gorman, for certification.

2 MR. THOMPSON: All right. Well, thank  
3 you for that. I -- therefore, I'll move that we  
4 certify that final ANC result.

5 MS. GREENFIELD: I second it.

6 MR. THOMPSON: All in favor?

7 Obviously both of us, so --

8 MS. GREENFIELD: Aye.

9 MR. THOMPSON: With that we certify  
10 that ANC race.

11 MS. STROUD: Yes, thank you. And with  
12 that, I just want to inform everyone that,  
13 because the certification has taking place today,  
14 there is a seven-day period during which any --  
15 during which candidates could seek a recount or  
16 any voter may request judicial review of the  
17 election. So, that would expire on December  
18 20th, 2024.

19 MS. EVANS: Thank you. And Mr. Chair,  
20 the only other thing I would just add for the  
21 record, and we did issue a press release, but  
22 just so that you know, we did have one recount in

1 ANC SMD 3/4G05, Precinct 50, and the results did  
2 not change as a result of that recount. There  
3 was a two vote difference and Karrenthya Simmons  
4 remains the winner of that contest. So, that  
5 certify contest remains as it was certified on  
6 December 2nd, so just FYI.

7 MR. THOMPSON: Yeah, thanks for that.  
8 I tuned in a little bit, but there isn't much to  
9 watch from Zoom. But I do want to thank Kevin  
10 Newsom and Millicent Wright and, you know,  
11 everybody who sat down to do that. It's not an  
12 easy chore, it took a couple hours, so I didn't  
13 pay attention to all of it.

14 But I was also pleased to see that,  
15 you know, the count was spot on. You know, so  
16 it's a measure of comfort that, you know, we --  
17 our original count of the votes was spot on  
18 accurate. So, thank you.

19 MS. EVANS: Yes, thank you.

20 MR. THOMPSON: All right, I guess  
21 that's all we have. And this might be our very  
22 last board meeting of 2024.

1 MS. GREENFIELD: Oh, wow.

2 (Laughter.)

3 MR. THOMPSON: So, thank you everybody  
4 for an interesting year of many ups and downs.  
5 And with that I would move to adjourn.

6 MS. GREENFIELD: And I second it.  
7 Everyone have a happy and safe holiday.

8 MR. THOMPSON: Yep.

9 MS. STROUD: Thank you, and same to  
10 you.

12 MS. EVANS: You, too. Thank you.  
13 Bye.

14 MS. GREENFIELD: Okay.
