Candidate Ballot Access Period Opens Tuesday, February 18

Washington, DC—The District of Columbia Board of Elections (DCBOE) announces that the candidate ballot access period for the July 15, 2025 Ward 8 Special Election will open on Tuesday, February 18, 2025, and run through Thursday, April 17, 2025, at 5:00 pm.

Beginning on Tuesday, February 18, 2025, petitions for the Ward 8 Member of the Council of the District of Columbia may be obtained at 1015 Half Street SE, Suite 750, until 5:00 pm on Thursday, April 17, 2025, which is the final day to submit nominating petitions. Petitions may also be obtained electronically by emailing the required paperwork to <u>candidate@dcboe.org</u>.

During this pick-up period, DCBOE's Voter Services team is available to assist candidates with the process on weekdays from 8:15 am to 4:45 pm, with exceptions being made for any holidays.
