Communication Assistance

District of Columbia Relay (DC Relay) provides traditional relay services for the District of Columbia, including teletypewriters (TTY), Voice Carry Over (VCO), Hearing Carry Over (HCO), Speech-to-Speech (STS), Spanish-to-Spanish, and CapTel®.

When you connect with DC Relay, a Communication Assistant (CA) will facilitate the call. Simply give the CA the number you wish to call, and your call will be processed promptly, professionally, and accurately.

Important Information

Non-citizen DC Residents and Voting

The Local Resident Voting Rights Amendment Act of 2022 allows non-citizen DC residents to vote in local elections held in the District of Columbia. A local election is an election for any of the following offices or ballot questions:

- Mayor;
- Chairman or member of the Council;
- Attorney General;
- Member of the State Board of Education;
- Advisory Neighborhood Commissioner;
- Initiative;
- Referendum;
- Recall; and
- Charter amendment.

Non-citizen DC residents cannot vote in elections for the following offices:

- US President and Vice-President (including presidential electors);
- Delegate to the US House of Representatives;
- US Senator;
- US Representative; and
- Officials of political parties (National Committeepersons and alternates, Nominating Convention Delegates and alternates, and Members and Officials of local committees of political parties).

THERE ARE TWO WAYS TO VOTE:

1) VOTE USING A MAIL-IN BALLOT

Every active registered voter will be mailed a ballot for the November 5, 2024 General Election. Voters can return their voted ballots using the following methods:

US Postal Service: Voted ballots returned via the US Postal Service must be postmarked by November 5, 2024 and received by November 15, 2024.

Mail Ballot Drop Box: Voters can return a voted ballot using any of the 55 Mail Ballot Drop Boxes located throughout the District of Columbia. A listing of locations can be found on pages 9–10 of this guide or by visiting www.dcboe.org.

Vote Center: Voters can return a voted ballot to any Vote Center during hours of operation.

Important Information

Military and Overseas Voters

Additional services are available to military and overseas voters (including members of the uniformed services and their spouses and/or dependents). US citizens who were born overseas have the opportunity to vote from the same address where a parent most recently lived in the District of Columbia.

Military and overseas voters can use the Federal Post Card Application (FPCA), which serves as a combined Voter Registration and Absentee Ballot request document. The FPCA is available for download from the US Department of Defense's Federal Voting Assistance Program (FVAP) at www.fvap.gov/district-of-columbia. You may email your completed FPCA to uocava@dcboe.org.

You can receive and return your Absentee Ballot by mail, fax, or email. Requests for Absentee Ballots must be received by November 2, 2024 at 4:45 pm. Emailed or faxed voted ballots must arrive at the DC Board of Elections (DCBOE) by November 5, 2024 at 8:00 pm. Voted Absentee Ballots must be postmarked by Election Day, November 5, 2024 and arrive at DCBOE by November 15, 2024. If it is getting close to Election Day and you have not received your Absentee Ballot, you can use the Federal Write-In Absentee Ballot (FWAB) as an emergency backup ballot. FVAP provides fillable FWABs and provides assistance with using FWABs at www.fvap.gov/district-of-columbia.

Eligible Incarcerated Voters

Registered individuals at the Central Detention Facility (CDF) and the Correctional Treatment Facility (CTF), and those incarcerated at Federal Bureau of Prisons facilities and/or other correctional facilities may vote in the November 5, 2024 General Election. These individuals will be mailed a ballot. All voted ballots must be postmarked by November 5, 2024 and received by November 15, 2024. Those in the CDF and CTF may also have the opportunity to vote in person in their facilities during Early Voting from October 29–31, 2024.

Eligible Individuals in Licensed Nursing and Assisted-Living Facilities

Registered individuals who are living—temporarily or permanently—at licensed District of Columbia nursing homes, assisted-living facilities, or federal medical centers may vote in the November 5, 2024 General Election. These residents may vote at a Vote Center or request a Mail-in Ballot be sent to a different address. All voted ballots must be postmarked by November 5, 2024 and received by November 15, 2024.

2) VOTE IN PERSON

You can cast your ballot in person at any Vote Center, regardless of your residential address.

During Early Voting, voters can vote at ANY of the 25 Early Vote Centers. On Election Day, voters may vote at ANY of the 75 Election Day Vote Centers. Vote Center locations can be found on pages 6–8 of this guide or by visiting www.dcboe.org.

- 55 Mail Ballot Drop Boxes will be open from 12:00 pm on October 11, 2024 until 8:00 pm on November 5, 2024.

TUESDAY, October 15, 2024

- Deadline for the receipt of voter registration applications submitted by mail or online.

MONDAY, October 28, 2024 – SUNDAY, November 3, 2024: EARLY VOTING

- 25 Early Vote Centers will be open from 8:30 am – 7:00 pm. These Vote Center locations are also open on General Election Day, November 5, 2024.

SATURDAY, November 2, 2024

- This is the deadline for receipt of **military and overseas voter** ballot requests.
- Requests for ballots must be received by 4:45 pm.

TUESDAY, November 5, 2024: GENERAL ELECTION DAY — LAST DAY TO VOTE!

- 75 Vote Centers will be open from 7:00 am – 8:00 pm.
- As long as you are in line by 8:00 pm, you will be able to vote.
- All ballots sent via the US Postal Service must be postmarked by November 5, 2024 *and* received by DCBOE by November 15, 2024 in order to be counted.

Frequently Asked Questions

How do I update my voter registration information?

Check your voter registration and update any information at www.dcboe.org/register tovote.

Can I still register to vote and cast a ballot after in-person voting has begun?

Same-day voter registration is available in the District of Columbia. You can register to vote and cast your ballot at any Early Vote Center or Election Day Vote Center. For same-day registration, you must provide proof of residence. Acceptable forms of proof of residence can be found at www.dcboe.org/register tovote.

What if I do not receive my Mail-in Ballot?

You may contact DCBOE at (202) 727-2525 if you do not receive your ballot. If you do not receive your ballot by November 1, 2024, please plan to vote in person.

How do I track my ballot?

You can track the status of your ballot by visiting www.dcboe.org or by calling (202) 727-2525.

Where do I find information about the best time to vote?

Use The Queue, available at www.dcboe.org, to see real-time wait times at Early Vote Centers.

The Queue will not be available on Election Day, November 5, 2024.

When will election results be released?

On Election Night, the totals for all ballots that have been processed by that point (including ballots received by mail, ballots deposited at Mail Ballot Drop Boxes, and ballots cast at Vote Centers) will be released. **DCBOE will update results to include totals for ballots received through November 15, 2024, the deadline for receipt of all mailed ballots.**

Official election results *will not* be released until after mail and valid special ballots have been processed and tabulated, a post-election audit has been conducted, and DCBOE has certified the election results.

Prohibited Activity / Accessible Voting

Prohibited Activity

In the District of Columbia, it is against the law to:

- make false statements about one's eligibility to register, vote, or hold elective office;
- interfere with a person who is attempting to register or vote;
- bribe or intimidate any voter during an election;
- vote more than once in an election;
- steal or hide votes cast in an election, or obtain, cast, or count false or fake ballots;
- pay, offer to pay, or accept anything of value for registering or voting; or
- obtain or submit false or fake voter registration applications.

Any person found guilty of engaging in illegal activities may be fined up to \$10,000, imprisoned up to five (5) years, or both.

Accessible Voting

DCBOE is committed to ensuring that every voter has equal access to the voting process. DCBOE's Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)/Language Access Coordinator is responsible for coordinating DCBOE's efforts to increase access and encourage participation by voters with disabilities, senior citizens, and limited English proficient voters by providing the following services:

- Voter Assistance Clerks and ADA Compliance Assistants are available to assist with the voting process. In addition, voters may receive assistance with the voting process from anyone they choose (including persons who accompany them to the voting location), other than poll watchers, election observers, their employer or their employer's agent, or an officer or

agent of their union. Any individual who assists a voter must complete the List of Assisted Voters Form at the voting location.

- Individuals who provide assistance to voters must not influence the voter's vote, mark the voter's ballot in a way other than the way the voter requested, or tell anyone how the voter voted.
- Vote Centers will be equipped with in-person and/or video interpreting technology. Voters will have access to more than 40 languages (including American Sign Language), language access kits (translated voting information), bilingual election workers, and multilanguage signs/posters.
- DCBOE operates an Election Day hotline, **(202) 727-5411**, dedicated to assisting voters who encounter accessibility and language access issues.
- If you need a reasonable accommodation to vote, have questions concerning these services, or would like to receive this information in an alternative language or format (for example, Braille, large print), please email the ADA/Language Access Coordinator at **ada@dcboe.org** or call **(202) 727-5411 (711 TTY)**.



Voter Rights and Responsibilities

As a voter in the District of Columbia, you have the right to:

- Be treated with courtesy and respect by election officials.
- Vote free from discrimination, intimidation, threat, or coercion.
- Receive instructions from election officials on how to cast your ballot.
- Inspect a sample ballot and other voting information posted in the Vote Center.
- Bring voter information materials into the voting booth.
- Vote privately and independently.
- Vote in an accessible Vote Center with accessible voting equipment.
- Receive language access services if you are limited- or non-English proficient.
- Have a ballot brought to your vehicle instead of entering the Vote Center if you are 65 years of age or older, or if you have a disability.
- Ask for and receive assistance with voting from anyone you choose (other than a poll watcher, an election observer, your employer, or an officer from your union), including an election worker if you have a disability, are visually impaired, or cannot read or write.
- Bring resources inside the Vote Center that will help you manage your disability, including wheelchairs, canes, walkers, service items, etc.
- Vote using a special (provisional) ballot if your eligibility to vote is in question.
- Learn whether your special (provisional) ballot was counted and, if not, why not.
- Receive at least two hours of paid leave to vote if you are employed in the District of Columbia.
- Receive an excused absence for at least two hours to vote if you are enrolled in an educational institution in the District of Columbia.

- Receive up to two replacement ballots if you make a mistake before casting your ballot.
- Vote if you are in line at the time the polls close.

As a voter in the District of Columbia, it is your responsibility to:

- Know your voting options.
- Treat election workers with courtesy and follow their instructions.
- Keep your voter registration information (name, address, party affiliation status) up-to-date with DCBOE.
- Familiarize yourself with the candidates and measures on the ballot.
- Bring the proper documentation with you to the Vote Center if you are required to show proof of residence.
- Make sure you have received the correct ballot before you vote.
- Respect the privacy of other voters.
- Report any problems or violations of election laws to the Site Coordinator.
