

July 15, 2025 Special Election Calendar of Important Dates and Deadlines

Election to Fill a Vacancy in:
Ward 8 Member of the Council of the District of Columbia

Wednesday February 5, 2025

Board receives Resolution from the D.C. Council regarding a vacancy in Office of Ward 8 Member of the Council of the District of Columbia [D.C. Official Code § 1-204.01(d)(1)].

Friday, February 14, 2025

Board certifies vacancy in Office of Ward 8 Member of the Council of the District of Columbia.

Board calls special election to fill vacancy to be held on **July 15**, **2025** [D.C. Official Code § 1-204.01(d)(1); 3 DCMR §§ 910.2 and 910.3 (BOE to conduct the special election be held on a Tuesday occurring at least seventy (70) days and not more than one hundred seventy-four (174) days after the date on which such vacancy occurs.)].

Board causes notice of the vacancy to be given on the Board's website and in the D.C. Register.

Monday, February 17, 2025

Office Closed (Observation of Presidents Day).

Tuesday, February 18, 2025

Board makes nominating petition available [3 DCMR § 910.4 (within seven days after certification of vacancy)].

<u>Signature requirements</u>: 500 duly registered voters who reside in the same ward from which the candidate seeks election [D.C. Official Code § 1-1001.08(j)(1); 3 DCMR § 910.5].

Wednesday, April 16, 2025

Office Closed (Observation of Emancipation Day).

Thursday, April 17, 2025 (5:00 p.m.)

Last day to file nominating petitions, petition supplements, Declarations of Candidacy, and any other affidavits, forms, or declarations required for the particular office sought [D.C. Official Code §§ 1-1001.08 (j)(1), 1-1021.01; 3 DCMR § 910.5 (Ballot access qualifications and rules are same as rules for direct nomination to the office in a general election); 3 DCMR §§ 601.5 and 1605.2 (90 days before the election)].

Sunday, April 20, 2025

Nominating petitions are posted for a 10-day challenge period that ends on **Tuesday**, **April 29, 2025 at 5:00 p.m.** [D.C. Official Code § 1-1001.08(o)(1); 3 DCMR § 1606.1 (third day after nominating petition filing deadline)].

Monday, April 21, 2025 - Monday, May 12, 2025

Period during which signers of nominating petitions may file change of address forms with the Board [D.C. Official Code §§ 1-1001.08(o)(3)(B), 1-1021.01; 3 DCMR § 1607.1(b) (changes of address must be filed by no later than 5:00 p.m. on the 10th day after the day the candidate **receives notice** of the challenge)].

Tuesday, April 22, 2025

Last day for Executive Director to provide preliminary determination of candidates' eligibility [3 DCMR § 601.6 (third business day after the deadline for filing a Declaration of Candidacy)].

Tuesday, April 29, 2025 (5:00 p.m.)

Close of 10-day nominating petition challenge period. [D.C. Official Code § 1-1001.08(o)(1); 3 DCMR § 1606.1].

Friday, May 16, 2025

Deadline for Board to provide notice to persons eligible to vote absentee in federal elections pursuant to the Uniformed and Overseas Citizen Absentee Voting Act (UOCAVA) of all contests and questions appearing on the ballot. Notice shall be provided on the Board's website, www.dcboe.org [D.C. Official Code §1-1061.16(a) (60 days before the election)].

Monday, May 19, 2025

Last day for Board to determine the validity of challenges to nominating petitions [D.C. Official Code § 1-1001.08(o)(2); 3 DCMR § 1606.5) (within 20 days after the challenge to the nominating petition is filed)].

Tuesday, May 20, 2025

[TENTATIVE] Last day for Board to give notice on its website of the pre-election logic and accuracy ("L & A") testing of the voting equipment to be used in the election [assumes testing begins Tuesday, May 27, 2025] [3 DCMR § 801.3 (at least seven days before the L & A testing period begins)].

Thursday, May 22, 2025

Last day for either challenger or nominee to appeal to D.C. Court of Appeals for review of the Board's determination regarding the validity of nominating petition challenge [D.C. Official Code § 1001.08(o)(2) (within three days after Board determines validity of challenge)].

Last day for candidates to submit affidavits withdrawing their nominations so that their names are not printed on the official election ballot [3 DCMR §§ 603.4 and 603.5 (54 days before the election)]. (The names of candidates who submit affidavits of withdrawal after this deadline may still appear on the ballot, but the Board shall provide notice of any withdrawals in Vote Centers.)

Friday, May 23, 2025

[TENTATIVE] Board to conduct public lottery to determine ballot positions [D.C. Official Code § 1-1001.08(p); 3 DCMR § 1204.1].

Monday, May 26, 2025

Office Closed (Observation of Memorial Day).

Tuesday, May 27, 2025

[TENTATIVE] Board to begin conducting pre-election L & A testing of the voting equipment to be used in the election (assumes notice given on or before Tuesday, May 20, 2025) [3 DCMR § 801.2].

Friday, May 30, 2025

Deadline for Board to transmit validly requested ballots to persons eligible to vote pursuant to the Uniformed and Overseas Citizen Absentee Voting Act (UOCAVA) where requests were received at least 45 days before the election [D.C. Official Code §§ 1-1061.09(a), 1-1021.01 (no later than 45 days before the election)].

Deadline for Board to publish, if necessary, updated election notice for UOCAVA voters. Notice originally posted on Board's website on **Friday, May 16, 2025** [D.C. Official Code §§ 1-1061.16(c), 1-1021.01 (no later than 45 days before the election)].

Monday, June 2, 2025

Last day for registered qualified electors to submit application to correct the voter registration list or challenge the right to vote of a person named on the list [D.C. Official Code §§ 1-1001.07(e)(5)(A), 1-1021.01; 3 DCMR § 521.2(b) (no later than 45 days before the election)].

Deadline for Board to post alphabetical lists of registered qualified electors current as of 60 days preceding the election (**Monday, May 16, 2025**) in public libraries as follows: one citywide listing in main public library, and one ward listing in every branch library located within the respective ward [D.C. Official Code §§ 1-1001.07(h)(1), 1-1021.01 (no later than 45 days before the election)].

Monday, June 9, 2025

[TENTATIVE] Board begins mailing ballots to registered voters.

Friday, June 13, 2025

[TENTATIVE] Board shall publicly announce the date and method by which it intends to randomly select precincts, voter-verifiable records tabulated centrally, and contests for the manual audit, and the date on which the manual audit will begin. [D.C. Official Code § 1001.09a(d), (e); 3 DCMR § 812.5(a) (announce no later than three days after tabulation complete)].

Thursday, June 19, 2025

Office Closed (Observation of Juneteenth).

Friday, June 20, 2025

[TENTATIVE] Board publicly conducts and announces the results of the random selection of precincts, voter-verifiable records tabulated centrally, and contests for the manual audit [D.C. Official Code § 1-1001.09a(d); 3 DCMR §§ 812.8 and 812.9.].

Tuesday, June 24, 2025

Deadline for registered qualified electors to change party affiliation status [D.C. Official Code §§ 1-1001.07(g)(4)(A)(i)(B); 3 DCMR § 504.5 (no later than 21 days before the election; requests for change of party affiliation status received after the 21st day before an election shall be held and processed after the election.)].

Deadline for receipt of all voter registration applications (including federal postcard applications (FPCAs), federal write in absentee ballots (FWABs)) and updates except for those submitted in person at the Board or at voter registration agencies [D.C. Official Code §§ 1-1001.07(g)(1)-(3); 3 DCMR § 504.3 (21 days before the election)].

First day the Board can publish a sample copy of the official ballot in at least one newspaper of general circulation [D.C. Official Code § 1-1001.05(a)(6); 3 DCMR § 1201.1 (not more than 21 days before the election)].

Thursday, June 26, 2025

Deadline to petition for poll watcher and election observer credentials at Vote Centers and counting places; the Board may accept additional petitions after this date based upon available space [D.C. Official Code § 1-1001.09(c); 3 DCMR §706.3 (not less than 14 days before the election)].

Monday, June 30, 2025

Deadline for receipt of ballot requests from non-UOCAVA voters [3 DCMR § 720.5 (no later than 15 days before the election)].

Tuesday, July 1, 2025

Deadline for Board to post a revised citywide list of registered qualified electors in the main public library, and a revised ward list of registered voters in every branch library located within the respective wards [D.C. Official Code § 1-1001.07(h)(2) (list must be posted for a period of no less than 14 days before the election)].

Thursday, July 3, 2025

Deadline for Board to make a determination on timely filed petitions for poll watchers and election observers credentials [D.C. Official Code § 1-1021.01; 3 DCMR § 706.8 (not less than 10 days before the election)]. If access is denied, notice must issue within 24 hours of denial [D.C. Official Code § 1-1001.09(c-1)].

Friday July 4, 2025

Office Closed (Observation of Fourth of July).

<u>Tuesday, July 8, 2025 – Thursday, July 10, 2025</u>

Period during which registered qualified electors may challenge the qualifications of prospective non-UOCAVA voters who submitted written requests for ballots [3 DCMR §§ 721.3 and 721.4 (for three days beginning seven days before the election)].

Friday, July 11, 2025 - Monday, July 14, 2025

Period during which qualified electors may register and cast ballots at Ward 8 Early Vote Centers. Early Vote Centers are open every day during this period between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. [D.C. Official Code § 1-1001.09(b-1)(1)-(2); 3 DCMR §§ 700.4 and 702.2 (for no more than 12 days before the election)].

Saturday, **July 12**, **2025**

Deadline for UOCAVA voters to request a ballot [3 DCMR § 720.5 (no later than three days before the election)].

TUESDAY, JULY 15, 2025 – SPECIAL ELECTION DAY

On Election Day, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., qualified electors may register to vote and cast full ballots in person at Ward 8 Vote Centers. All voters who are in line at 8:00 p.m. may cast a ballot [D.C. Official Code §§ 1-1001.10(a)(4) and (b)(14); 3 DCMR § 703.1-2].

Deadline (8:00 p.m.) to deposit ballots at Vote Centers or the Board office, and for the receipt of all electronically transmitted ballots. [D.C. Official Code §§ 1-1001.05(a)(10B)(B)].

Tuesday, **July 22**, **2025**

Deadline (5:00 p.m.) for write-in candidate to file an Affirmation of Write-In Candidacy or Declaration of Candidacy with the Board to be eligible for nomination to office [D.C.

Official Code § 1-1001.08(r)(3); 3 D.C.M.R. § 602.2 (no later than seven days after the election)].

Last day for voters who cast special ballots to present verification of eligibility to vote in the election [3 DCMR § 700.6 (no later than the seventh day after the election)].

Date Board provides toll-free telephone service (1-866-DCVOTES (1-866-328-6837)) and website service, www.dcboe.org, where any voter who cast a challenged or special ballot can learn the Board's preliminary decision whether to count or reject their ballot and the reason for the decision [D.C. Official Code § 1-1001.09(e)(2)].

Wednesday, July 23, 2025 – Friday, July 25, 2025

Board holds special or challenged ballot hearings [D.C. Official Code § 1-1001.09(e)(3)-(4); 3 DCMR § 712.4 (no earlier than eight days and no later than 10 days after the election)].

Board makes final determination on validity of special and challenged ballots [D.C. Official Code § 1-1001.09(e)(3)-(4); 3 DCMR § 712.7 (the day after the hearing)].

Thursday, July 24, 2025 – Monday, July 28, 2025

Last day to appeal Board's decision on the validity of special ballots to the D.C. Superior Court [D.C. Official Code § 1-1001.09(e)(3)-(4); 3 DCMR § 712.8 (the next business day after the date of the Board's decision)].

Friday, July 25, 2025

Deadline for receipt of all mailed ballots [D.C. Official Code § 1-1001.05(a)(10B)].

Thursday, July 31, 2025

Deadline to cure mail ballots.

Friday, August 1, 2025

[TENTATIVE] Final count of mail ballots and accepted special and challenged ballots.

Monday, August 4, 2025 - Wednesday, August 6, 2025

[TENTATIVE] Board conducts public manual audit of the voter-verifiable records tabulated [D.C. Official Code § 1001.09a(b), (c); 3 DCMR § 812.2].

Thursday, August 7, 2025

[TENTATIVE] Board to publish on its website and make available for public inspection a report of results of the manual audit [D.C. Official Code § 1-1001.09a(j) (prior to certification of election results)].

Friday, August 8, 2025

[TENTATIVE] Certification of election results [D.C. Official Code § 1-1001.05(a)(11); 3 DCMR § 813.1].

Friday, August 15, 2025

[TENTATIVE] Last day for a voter in the election to file a petition for review of the results of the election in the D.C. Court of Appeals [D.C. Official Code § 1-1001.11(b)(1) (within seven days after the certification)].

[TENTATIVE] Last day for a candidate in the election to request a recount of the certified votes cast in one or more voting precincts [D.C. Official Code § 1-1001.11(a)(1) (within seven days after the certification)].
