2026 Ballot Access & Petition Circulation Trainings

FOR CANDIDATES, PROPONENTS OF BALLOT MEASURES, AND PETITION CIRCULATORS

The DC Board of Elections Voter Services Division will conduct virtual training sessions for candidates, proponents of ballot measures, and petition circulators. The sessions will provide an overview of the Board's guidelines and policies for circulating nominating and ballot measure petitions. Attendees will also be able to ask questions about the process and get access to additional resources.

Training sessions will take place the second and fourth Tuesday of every month from January through August and will last approximately 45-60 minutes. Please plan to be on time. Attendees should sign into Zoom at least 5 minutes prior to the start of the Zoom session. Anyone who is more than 10 minutes late, will not receive credit for attending.
