 1. Proposed Rulemaking
 - a. Amend Chapters 1 and 3-20. The purpose of the amendments to these regulations is to have them conform with District law, including the Local Residents Voting Rights Amendment Act of 2022. The rulemaking also reflects court decisions rendered in cases concerning Initiative Measure No. 82, “the “District of Columbia Tip Credit Elimination Act of 2021.” In addition, the rulemaking updates and/or clarifies Board procedures for various activities, including meetings (including hearings), the issuance of Board orders and advisory opinions, and ballot access for candidates and ballot measures. The amendments also make other non-substantive housekeeping updates and corrections of typographical and formatting errors.
