13 Certification of the June 14, 2016 Federal and Local

14 Primary Election Results.

1 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: Okay. Good afternoon.

2 My name is Michael Bennett, Chair of the DC Board of
3 Elections. I want to call this meeting to order. We
4 have one order of business. Before that I want to just
5 for the record to -- move my chair up -- make sure that
6 everybody knows who's on the dais. To the far left is
7 Terri Stroud, Acting Executive Director of the Board of
8 Elections. To the far right is Michael Gill, Board
9 Member, and to my immediate right is Ken McGhie, General
10 Counsel for the Board of Elections. And I'm Michael
11 Bennett. We have a quorum; two board members, myself
12 and Mike Gill so we are to conduct business.

13 We have one order -- one item as a order of
14 business today and that is certification of the
15 election. And that I'd ask Executive Director -- Acting
16 Executive Director Terri Stroud to read the report and
17 we'll move from there.

18 DIRECTOR STROUD: Okay. Good afternoon
19 everyone. On Tuesday, June 14th, 2016 the Board
20 conducted primary elections for the Democratic,
21 Republican, and DC Statehood Green parties.

22 I will read into the record the names of the

1 winners of the contests that appeared on the ballot by
2 primary beginning with the Democratic Party, continuing
3 with the Republican Party, and concluding with the DC
4 Statehood Green party.

5 So I'll read the contest, the winner, and
6 the amount of votes that the winner received.

7 I'll also request that the Board allow for
8 the certification of documents for each contest to be
9 included in the record once they have been signed. And
10 each of the contests where no winner is declared no
11 candidate was eligible or qualified for election.

12 So the Democratic Party, the winner of the
13 Presidential Preference contest in the Democratic Party
14 Primary is Hillary Clinton. She received 76,704 votes.

15 Delegate to the US House of Representatives,
16 the winner Eleanor Holmes Norton received 90,801 votes.

17 At-large Member of the Council contest, the
18 winner was Robert White with 38,805 votes.

19 The Ward 2 Member of the Council, Jack
20 Evans, 7,626 votes.

21 Ward 4 Member of the Council, Brandon Todd
22 is the winner, 8,145 votes.

1 Ward 7 Member of the Council, the winner is
2 Vincent C. Gray who received 6,333 votes.

3 Ward 8 Member of the Council, Trayon "Ward
4 Eight" White received 4,272 votes.

5 The United States Representative Franklin
6 Garcia the winner there, received 75,186 votes.

7 Now for the Republican Party. There was no
8 winner in the delegate to the US House of
9 Representatives contest.

10 At-large Member of the Council, the winner
11 was Carolina Celnik, 1,270 votes.

12 No winner in the Ward 2 Member of the
13 Council contest.

14 No winner in the Ward 4 Member of the
15 Council contest.

16 No winner in the Ward 7 Member of the
17 Council contest.

18 No winner in the Ward 8 Member of the
19 Council contest.

20 No winner in the United States
21 Representative contest.

22 National Committeeman contest, the winner is

1 Bob Kabel, 1,292 votes.

2 The National Committeewoman, the winner is
3 Jill Homan, 1,320 votes.

4 The Chairperson of the DC Republican
5 Committee for Ward 1, the winner Michael McHugh received
6 106 votes.

7 Chairperson of the DC Republican Committee
8 for Ward 2, winner Gary P. Kraiss, Junior received 219
9 votes.

10 The Chairperson of the DC Republican
11 Committee for Ward 3, the winner Robert Hyman received
12 327 votes.

13 There is no winner in the Chairperson of the
14 DC Republican Committee Ward 4 contest.

15 The Chairperson of the DC Republican
16 Committee for Ward 5, the winner Joe Brookman received
17 99 votes.

18 The Chairperson of the DC Republican
19 Committee for Ward 6, the winner Stephen Jackson
20 received 318 votes.

21 The Chairperson of the DC Republican
22 Committee for Ward 7, the winner there is Robert T.

1 (Bob) Richards. He received 78 votes.

2 No winner in the Chairperson of the DC
3 Republican Committee for Ward 8 contest.

4 Onto the DC Statehood Green Party Primary.

5 The winner of the delegate to the US House of
6 Representatives contest was Natale (Lino) Stracuzzi. He
7 received 326 votes.

8 At-large Member of the Council contest, the
9 winner there G. Lee Aikin received 280 votes.

10 There was no winner in the Ward 2 Member of
11 the Council contest, no winner in the Ward 4 Member of
12 the Council contest, no winner in the Ward 7 Member of
13 the Council contest, no winner in the Ward 8 Member of
14 the Council contest, no winner in the United States
15 Representative contest in the DC Statehood Green Party
16 Primary.

17 That concludes the reading of the
18 certifications into the record, and I request that the
19 Board consider a motion to certify the results of the
20 election as indicated.

21 CHAIRPERSON BENNETT: Second to the motion.

22 BOARD MEMBER GILL: I move to certify the

1 results as indicated.

2 CHAIRPERSON BENNETT: I second. All
3 opposed? (No audible response.) In favor? (Chorus of
4 ayes.)

5 And do we have any other business for the
6 board today? Okay. We're going to adjourn the meeting
7 and -- but stay here, and we will sign the
8 certifications going forward. Thank you. And the
9 meeting was adjourned.

10 (Whereupon the above-entitled matter was
11 concluded.)
