So, the short title and summary statement is deemed to be approved by the Board and we're here now today for the proposal of the initiative measure or its representative to formally adopt the petition and so, that it can begin circulating for the 180-day period.

The Board has prepared an original petition form and you've been given a copy of it.

MR. MCGHIE: Okay. The Register of Voters has prepare a -- like a proof of their calculation on the approximate signatures that will be needed for -- to have this places on the ballot and she is prepared to give you a statement now.

CHAIR NICHOLS: Madam Register of Voters, will you read your calculations into the record and outline the remainder of the initiative process for the proponents?

MS. BROOKS: Okay. As you are aware, petitions made in support of Initiative Measure Number 74, No Worker Shall Make Less Than The Minimum Wage Act of 2016 must contain the signature of 5 percent of voters registered in the District of Columbia provided that this total includes 5 percent of

1 the registered voters in 5 or more wards.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code

Section 120 -- 1204.102, this number is based
on the latest official count of registered

voters by the Board of Elections which was
issued 30 or more days prior to submission of
the signatures.

While signature requirement cannot yet be determined, I have calculated the information for the proponent and opponent what the signature requirement would be if the most recent voter registration figures published by the Board were used. The chart is indicated here.

advised to check with the Board on a monthly basis as new statistics are issued to get upto-date estimates of the signature requirement. The 100-day period for circulating a petition pursuant to D.C. Official Code Section 11001.16J1 expires on Wednesday, April 22, 2015 at 5:00 p.m.
