3	CHAIRMAN NICHOLS: Good morning,
4	and welcome. I hereby call to order the July
5	29th Special Meeting of the Board of Elections
6	for the purpose of certifying the results of
7	the July 15, 2014 Ward 8 Special Election for
8	the seat on the State Board of Education.
9	Again, it is Tuesday, July 29th.
10	The time is 10:36 a.m. And we are meeting in
11	280 North at One Judiciary Square.
12	I'm Deborah K. Nichols, Chairman
13	of the Board. Present with me this morning is
14	Mr. Stephen Danzansky, Member of the Board.
15	Also present on the dias, Mr. Ken McGhie, the
16	Board's General Counsel; Ms. Cecily Collier-
17	Montgomery, the Board's Director of Campaign
18	Finance; and Mr. Clifford Tatum, the Board's
19	Executive Director for Election
20	Administration.
21	Without objection, the agenda for
22	the meeting is hereby adopted.

1	I will now give the meeting over
2	to Mr. Tatum to read the results of the
3	Special Election of July 15th into the record.
4	MR. TATUM: Thank you, Madam
5	Chair.
6	As indicated, we had a July 15th
7	Special Election for a Member of the State
8	Board of Education. As a result of that
9	election, there were two candidates who ran
10	for the contest which means before the
11	election day itself. As based on our pre-
12	certification tabulation, Teirra Jolly
13	received 813 votes to become the winner of the
14	contest. Mr. Phillip Pannell received a total
15	of 733 votes, and Mr. Darrell Danny Jackson
16	received 67 votes. And there were a total of
17	88 write-ins thereby giving Ms. Jolly the win
18	for the contest itself.
19	Pursuant to D.C. law, the Board of
20	Elections conducted a post-election audit.
21	And on Friday of last week, the 25th, we
22	randomly selected Precinct number 117 to

1	conduct a manual audit of all of the voting
2	results, both the M100 as well as the
3	iVotronic including special ballots and
4	absentee ballots. The total number of votes
5	that were cast on the machine for Precinct 117
6	was 53. The total number of ballots counted
7	by hand was 53 leaving a zero variance. Thus
8	the audit was successfully concluded, and we
9	determined that there were no discrepancies
10	with the election results.
11	Accordingly, the Board is now in a
12	position to certify the election results. And
13	I'd ask for a motion from the Board to accept
14	the certification of the election and to
15	announce the winner as Ms. Teirra Jolly.
16	MEMBER DANZANSKY: Chair, I move
17	that this Board accept the results of
18	certification and certify the Special Election
19	of July 15 for State Board of Education to
20	fulfill the unfilled term.
21	CHAIRMAN NICHOLS: The motion is
22	before us.
